Interfaith Emergency Services (“IES”) is committed to respecting the privacy of our donors.

Information Collected. Here are the types of donor information that we collect and maintain:

- Contact information: name, organization/company, complete address, phone number, email address
- Donation information: amounts donated, date of donation(s), method and stimulus
- Information concerning hours you have volunteered
- Information for any memorial or honorary donations
- Your requests and comments

How Information is Used.

- IES uses your data to maintain records of donations, send acknowledgements, mail year-end tax statements to you and send newsletters. We normally add you to our mailing list, unless you request otherwise.
- Credit card numbers are NOT retained once processed. Our website has a SSL certificate. Donations over 2% of our entire budget must be reported on IRS Form 990, Schedule B.

No Sharing of Personal Information. IES will not sell, rent, trade or transfer your personal information to outside organizations. Use of donor information will be limited to the internal purposes of IES and only to further our mission. Nevertheless, security measures may not prevent all losses, and IES is not responsible for any damages or liabilities relating to security failures.
